Footing:	2 Large outdoor show arenas-sand. 120 by 66 indoor show arena. Warm up arena-sand for lunging.
Warm-up:	Indoor arena sand.
Dogs:	All dogs must be on a leash at all times.
Misc:	An ASTM approved helmet must be worn while on your horse.
